

61B What needs to be done to conserve verges

- 5 Southend Road always had grass cut, but not anymore on the houses side.
- 21 Reduce use of large vehicles on our roads
- 30 Enforcement of repairs to developers destruction on E H Road
- 33 Throughout Sandon verges are damaged by vehicles
- 45 Southend Road - Bridle Path should be maintained
- 52 There is a lot of encroachment - especially Butts Green Road and East Hanningfield Road
- 59 Increase cutting frequency/reinstae drainage/repair damage
- 63 Small lanes, big 4x4 and lorries
- 68 Protective bollards to stop lorries destroying them
- 85 Need to be better maintained by council
- 92 Passing places to be provided on narrow road ie Mayes Lane
- 107 More maintenance both privately and publicly funded
- 122 Sandon Brook Manor verge not regularly maintained
- 144 Mayes Lane has none - all worn away by lorries
- 146 All verges are being demolished by heavy vehicles
- 148 Restriction to prevent verges being destroyed by vehicles
- 153 Make sure they are not used by cars to park or use
- 170 The council need to maintain the verges
- 177 Woodhill Road and Hall Lane corner, clearer visibility needed.
- 180 Woodhill Road, Mayes Lane - reduce speeding
- 186 Heavy lorries entering commercial sites!!
- 189 Southlands chase to Chelmsford Nursing home (dangerous)
- 193 Woodhill Road and Hall Lane need significant improvements
- 198 Except stop parking on the village green - more posts
- 204 Mid-summer Brick Kiln Road needs tidying and Woodhill
- 211 Publicity/encouragement to residents - carbon footprint etc
- 212 Stop parking on verges eg school
- 218 Rubbish and unkempt verges in Woodhill Road
- 229 Prevent inappropriate sized vehicles driving down Mayes and Sporhams Lane: close one
- 232 Not aware anything is done to conserve verges - state of country roads is very bad
- 236 Maintenance on a more regular basis
- 244 Regular mowing, trimming, seasonal flowers
- 256 People doing away with verges in Hall Lane for parking
- 266 Cut back, but any sharp bits need to be picked up
- 269 Cut regularly and parking stopped
- 272 Continual damage along Woodhill Road
