Traffic

Sandon Brook Manor

- 119 Safety measures at Sandon Brook Manor/A414 - this is a major hazard
- 127 Safer access onto A414 from Sandon Brook Manor

Mayes Lane

- 63 Close quarry stop big vehicles in Mayes Lane and Hulls Lane

Speed/Volume

- 12 The volume of traffic - close the rat run to South Woodham
 - 26 Speed limits, use of speed cameras
 - 59 Traffic calming to provide greater safety for pedestrians and cyclists
 - 82 Access - HGV and speeding vehicles should be using A130
 - 104 Less industry of type that uses large lorries
 - 114 Lower speed limit on Maldon Road past Sandon Brook Manor
 - 122 The traffic and speed on Maldon Road
 - 151 Traffic using Howe Green as through road
 - 193 Reduce through traffic and its speed
 - 276 Brick Kiln Road, footpaths to encourage walking. Slower speeds

- 262 Less traffic using Woodhill Road to Danbury instead of main road

A12 Noise

- 198 The A12 to be resurfaced to reduce the traffic noise
- 194 We like the village as it stands, that is why we live here. Noise from A12 should be reduced
- 64 Traffic noise reduction from A12
- 7 Reduce noise and impact of the A12 bypass - screening and noise reduction

Parking

- 152 Off road parking and stop owners parking on grass verges
- 166 More off street parking and the return of a village shop to Sandon Village
- 292 Residential off road parking (green) Hall Lane

Roads and Paths

- 21 Cycle paths between Howe Green and village without using roads
- 86 Cycleways and footpaths to village away from roads
- 92 Re-establish more direct footpath access from Howe Green to Sandon
- 145 The village hall, heavy goods vehicles not to use Mayes Lane - POT HOLES!!
- 200 More push chair and wheelchair friendly
- 207 Brick Kiln Road should have a pavement or cycle path to park and ride
- 226 The state of the roads (potholes)
- 230 State of the roads, Sporhams Lane, Mayes Lane, Woodhill Common Road
- 238 Street lighting/Underground electricity/footpaths/buses

- 264 Improve Hammonds Lane or restrict to one way
- 276 Brick Kiln Road, footpaths to encourage walking. Slower speeds

Facilities

- 30 Weekday community facility such as a shop
- 240 Shop
- 294 If sustainable, a small shop, eg convenience general store, newsagent
- 246 Addition of local shop and better bus service
- 108 Some facilities in Howe Green - ie shop/s
- 166 More off street parking and the return of a village shop to Sandon Village
- 105 Not a lot, but a better equipped village hall
- 145 The village hall, heavy goods vehicles not to use Mayes Lane - POT HOLES!!
- 233 Move village hall to Glebe playing field, get off church land, place play area here too.
- 132 Facilities for children - scouts, youth clubs etc
- 204 Make it an appealing place to live for youth
- 225 A safe place for children to play
- 238 Street lighting/Underground electricity/footpaths/buses

Housing

- 67 More possibility for young families to live in parish
- 101 No development - keep Sandon as a village
- 142 Encourage younger to stay or come and live in the parish
- 212 More affordable housing/better bus service

Environment

- 107 Transform the village green and surroundings into a more picturesque focal point
- 153 Make it a smokeless zone (the village)
- 168 No .high voltage power lines above ground
- 179 Remove industrial area from Mayes Lane
- 211 Improve area around pond in Gablefields
- 238 Street lighting/Underground electricity/footpaths/buses
- 250 Remove silver birch trees in Hall Lane
- 254 resite electricity underground
