

68 Comments and Suggestions

9 Since the opening of the park and ride a lot more pedestrians are using Brick Kiln Road. Also the amount of traffic on this road has increased since its opening with no regard to the 30 mph speed limit entering the village. I think traffic calming measures as in Molrams Lane would be very beneficial.

20 Stop motor bikes speeding through Howe Green

32 Any further development should be strongly opposed

58 Cycle path between Chelmsford and Howe Green along by-pass

59 Establish further conservation areas

66 Reduce speed to prevent so many accidents outside my property (East Hanningfield Road) - 2 major crashes in 4 months

75 Some additional development is fine provide is mixed value and not too much

77 Restrict the size of houses/bungalows along Southend Road, Howe Green

93 Resurfacing of Southend Road is required

99 Traffic calming measures in Howe Green are very dangerous and wasteful on petrol.

103 The decision to allow heavy contractor vehicles and equipment eg road build up machines - to use Mayes Lane and Hulls Lane, when some years ago such vehicles used the A130 entrance to the gravel pits and environs the roads are systematically destroyed and repaired at rate payers cost. We are subsidising the Plant Hire company - Why?

115 I live in Sandon Brook Place exiting at the junction of Maldon Road/A414 is risky. I have been hit (and had a near miss this week - no traffic coming from Danbury oncoming car flashes to let me out following car swings out to overtake, and nearly meets me in the opposite carriage way). People park in Maldon Road/Sandon Brook place day and night leaving all sorts of rubbish for residents to remove.

119 Development of better sporting facilities - particularly of Sports Club building

123 To reinstate footpath from Park and Ride - both ways from Sandon Brook to Baddow

146 Develop the quarry for future development

152 Develop and creat a pride in the parish and village

153 More police coming into the village - day and night visits

169 If the speed limit in Woohill Road between Garrett Lands and Gablefields is not reduced to 30 mph with speed bumps/strips there will be a fatality very soon as there are more and more school children using this stretch of road on foot and by bicycle. The traffic continues to grow not only in numbers but in aggression.

- 171 There is a need for more cycle paths and foot paths in the parish as for those of us in the more rural areas it is not safe to walk or cycle. As it would be difficult to find space for this along most roads there is probably a need for a small working group(s) of residents/parish councillors to look at this on site and come up with some proposals.
- 175 To tidy up Sandon Brook at the bottom of Hall Lane and surrounding areas
- 198 Stop the speed of vehicles coming through the village we need, at least, speed humps
- 204 Happy to get more involved although time is limited
- 211 Council needs to publicise penalties for dumping and enforce them. Encourage civil responsibility
- 212 See 42a Covenant not to park being ignored
- 215 Clear up litter - happy to help if event is organised
- 227 Important to me to maintain rural character in open fields. Quieter A12 road surface needed as traffic increases. I would, in any future developments, only like to see dividing property partitions as one or two wooden fence panels where cars stand outside garages, plus hedges, shrubs, trees, open lawns, odd bit out of sight small low wall e.g. with shrubs would be acceptable. Preferably with gravel or porous M over grass because concrete and tarmac prevent drainage causing flooding. No need for high walls in rural villages, they have spoilt High Easter. There is one in the Lintons, Sandon Village, which block the views. They are unsightly.
