

## 70 Requests of parish council

- 4 Street lighting on Southend Road, Howe Green
- 5 Cut speeding traffic would help.
- 7 Try to reduce the road noise from the A12
- 9 Traffic calming to all roads into village
- 15 Not sure, not lived here long enough
- 21 Actively encourage a community spirit in parish
- 23 Restrict traffic speed (and volume) in E H Road
- 24 Limit through traffic including H G Vehicles on E H Road
- 40 Having bus service regularly for advantage of lots of people
- 54 Look at all speed restrictions and alter most of them
- 56 Traffic lights at Howe Green Roundabout and speed cameras on Southend Road.
- 73 Improve drainage, ditches particularly on rural roads
- 75 Please do something about our back roads.
- 88 Better access to information on footpaths/footpath maps available
- 95 They already know what I want done.
- 101 30mph sign to restrict speed limit in Woodhill Road through Sandon School to Woodhill common
- 104 Litter clearing - especially Hulls Lane
- 105 A better equipped village hall
- 106 Traffic problems - Woodhill Road - HGVs unlawful use
- 108 Create a facility in Howe Green (ie a shop or shops). Would also create a community
- 109 Since the construction of the park and ride, pedestrian traffic along A414 between Potash Farm (Sandon Brook Manor) and Brick Kiln Lane has increased substantially. The footpath previously linking the two areas need to be reinstated. Access to Potash Farm from A414:  
Suggested solutions:  
1. mini roundabout
- 117 Footpath along Maldon Road up to Danbury Park school so I can walk to school with my children
- 118 Provide walkway/cycle track from Sandon Brook development to Danbury
- 126 40mph speed limit down Hammonds Road
- 134 Try to cut down noise from A12 if possible
- 139 Continue 40mph limits up to Danbury Park. Steps taken to prevent HGV's from using Woodhill Road
- 143 Not to use the village as a tip for Chelmsford
- 144 More community police support officer presence

- 153 Try and ban bonfires in the village - we all can recycle
- 159 Reduce traffic from South Woodham Ferrers on East Hanningfield Road
- 176 Dropped kerbs in Woodhill Road
- 177 A seat or bench somewhere between Sandon and Great Baddow Vineyards
- 181 Traffic calming at Mayes Lane/Woodhill road Junction
- 185 We need speed and width reductins along Mayes Lane
- 192 As stated, serious control of traffic speed in Brick Kiln Road and Woodhill Road
- 193 Improve road surfaces including quieter surface to A12
- 194 NO shelters for teenagers. Protect village life.
- 196 Stricter control of traffic speeds
- 198 Traffic control through the village.
- 204 Village hall to be more a community centre - modernise/utilise it more.
- 205 Something needs to be done about the cars parking on the grass verges of Woodhill Road outside the school. Maybe posts like on Molrams Lane. Cars park on the verge and then pull across the path to get back on the road. Yesterday a van nearly hit my daughters pushchairs as it just pulled out without looking for pedestrians.
- 207 Put a pavement or cyclepath in Brick Kiln Road to Park and Ride
- 208 Reduce traffic/speed in village  
Improve highways/pathways
- 211 Run scheme (with volunteers) to clean up area of rubbish. This would shame people into not repeating the offence. This could be done on weekends with council providing collection vehicle and residents operating in small teams to collect rubbish etc. Minimal cost implication and support entry for Best Kept Village - joins up with other objectives and encourages pride of ownership. Parish council to act as civic leader initiative.
- 214 Sandon needs a convenience shop. Many people do not drive and buses are not very
- 215 Stop residents commercial vehicles parking in residential roads
- 233 Have a hanging basket competition to encourage village look
- 236 A shop is needed for the village
- 244 Organise some transport - help for OAPs
- 256 Stop parking on path outside school. Yellow Lines!!! They park on the path.
- 257 Somehow reduce the noise levels of A12
- 264 Improve road surfaces in back roads which have received no attention for years
- 271 Take note we do not want any more development in Sandon
- 272 Traffic calming - Woodhill Road
- 277 Rubbish etc cleared from the river at the bottom of Hall Lane and the bridge more maintained
- 281 Keep roads in a safe condition
